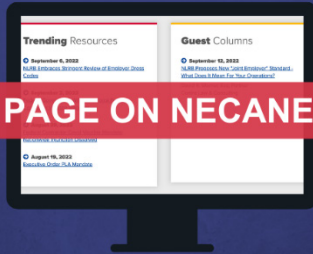

## **US DOL Launches Online Tool to Improve Federal Contractors' Reporting**

The U.S. Department of Labor today launched an online portal to help contracting officers, contractors, and subcontractors to provide required notices of federal construction contracts and subcontract awards. Executive Order 11246 requires contracting officers and contractors to submit a notice to OFCCP within 10 working days of the award of a federal or federally assisted construction contract or subcontract that exceeds \$10,000.
