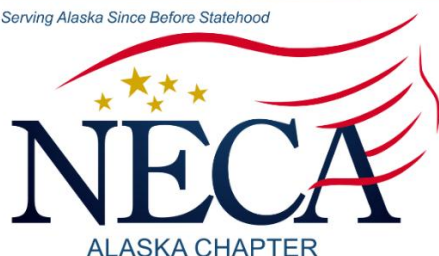

The Ohio DOT is underway with what it calls a record construction season that includes 955 projects — 38 of them considered “major” with a value above \$10 million — across the state, according to an April 3 news release. [Construction Dive](#)

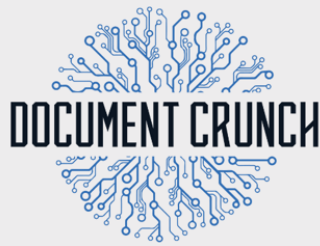
