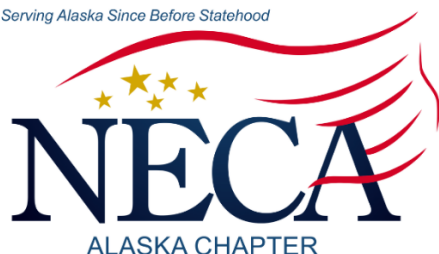

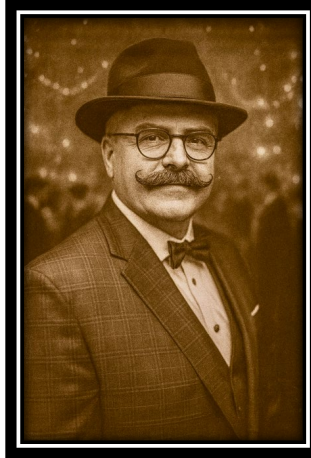

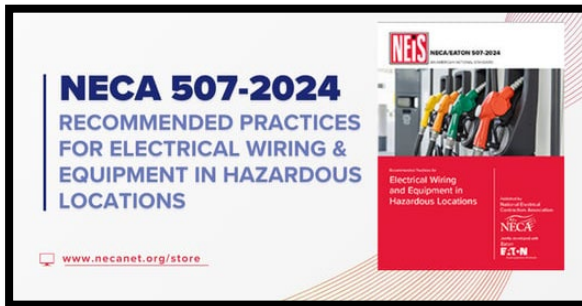

NEIS Standards Spotlight #2

NECA/EATON 507-2024 provides field-oriented guidance for safe installation and maintenance of electrical wiring and equipment in hazardous (classified) locations. It covers area classification, protection methods, equipment selection, wiring, grounding, bonding, and installation practices for locations where explosive gases, vapors, or combustible dusts may be present. By referencing NFPA 70 (NEC), NFPA 497, NFPA 499, and API RP 500/505, the standard supports both Division and Zone systems. Developed with EATON, it is a practical resource for electrical professionals in industrial and commercial hazardous environments.
