REMINDER: March 31, 2016, Deadline For Filing 2015 LM-10 Form

NECA contractors and chapter offices are reminded of the requirement to file Department of Labor Form LM-10 reporting certain specified dealings with a union or union officer, agent, shop steward, employee, or other representative of a union. These reports are due within 90 days after the end of the filer's fiscal year. Many filers have a fiscal year ending date of December 31, which means their 2015 report is due by March 31, 2016.

Learn How the MOU Between the DOL and DOJ Affects NECA Contractors

Are you aware that your personal liability relating to accidents on the job may have increased significantly? Based on the recent Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Labor, (DOL) and the Department of Justice, (DOJ), contractors and field management may find themselves personally responsible and personally liable in an OSHA lawsuit that seeks criminal prosecution and restitution for accidents in the workplace that result in a fatality or serious injuries. Owners must be knowledgeable about the incidents that occur involving their employees since they could be the ones who most likely be held accountable. OSHA wants to step up prosecution of willful and repeat violators to make examples of those executives who are not following the regulations and the law. This is one way to add more severe penalties to citations given after incidents in the workplace and also go after individuals in addition to corporate entities.
